

The Sam Weintraub Memorial Scholarship Award



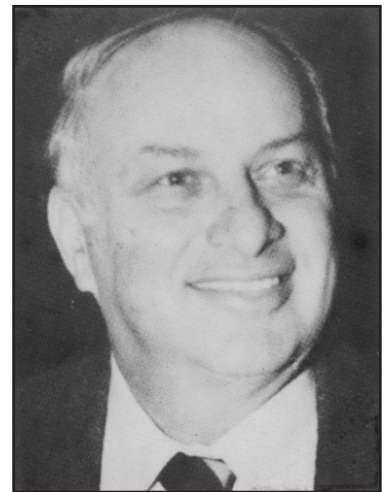
In Memory Of

Sam Weintraub served as BOMA's executive director from 1966 to 1987. During that time, his enthusiastic, colorful leadership helped BOMA grow into a highly visible, professional trade association of more than 400 local members. The vitality of BOMA today is tribute to Sam's vision and dedication.

He was president of Weintraub and Associates, Inc., an advertising and public relations company he founded in 1953. He was best known for his successful local, regional, and national advertising campaigns; the many awards for excellence he received in both print and broadcast media; and the local and statewide political campaigns and issue referendums the agency won for its clients.

Sam was married to Suzanne Weintraub, who still lives in St. Louis, and had three children: Larry, Rob and Sara. Larry and Rob went into the family business, now called Weintraub Advertising. Larry has been BOMA's executive director since 1987 and still places importance on his father's memorial scholarship, not only because it honors his father, but also because it rewards and furthers the academic accomplishments of a deserving, hard-working student. The Weintraub family's dedication to excellence and success has carried on throughout generations, just as Sam Weintraub would have wanted.

The Scholarship

TYPE OF SCHOLARSHIP

\$2,000 annual financial grant.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The scholarship award is established to recognize the achievements of individuals related to, or sponsored by, BOMA St. Louis members, with an objective of providing financial assistance to pursue completion of undergraduate or graduate level courses.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

A scholarship grant in the amount of \$2,000 is to be awarded to one candidate on an annual basis. The Scholarship Committee will review recommended candidates and select the best qualified, based on the selection procedure criteria. The Scholarship Committee has the final authority over selection of the winning candidate.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Candidates considered for the Sam Weintraub Memorial Scholarship must meet the following requirements:

1. Must be sponsored by a BOMA St. Louis member (who may also be a relative).
2. Must have gained official admission to, or be a student already enrolled in, an accredited college or university.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Candidates applying for the Sam Weintraub Memorial Scholarship must observe the following procedures and rules:

1. Applicants must submit an application form, completed in its entirety and bearing the applicant's signature, to be received by the Sam Weintraub Memorial Scholarship Committee no later than March 31 of each calendar year. The grant will be awarded during the summer of that year.
2. Applicants must provide a personally composed essay, no more than two pages in length, describing their career plans or regarding personal merit or individual needs.
3. Applicants must provide two single-page letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a BOMA St. Louis member.

4. Applicants must mail all application materials to:

5. Candidates must be available for a personal interview.

SELECTION PROCESS

- The Scholarship Committee will not consider a candidate who does not meet the above qualifications or fails to submit the above materials as described.
- Candidates who are personally responsible for paying their college expenses will receive additional consideration during the selection process.
- The Scholarship Committee will inform all applicants for the Sam Weintraub Memorial Scholarship of the outcome of the scholarship process.
- Unsuccessful candidates may be considered the following year or any year thereafter.
- Candidates must reapply each year.
